1. **Multiple temperature zones.** Approximately 45°F for the top two wine racks. Approximately 38°F for the two full tempered glass shelves and the lower half shelf that will hold other non-wine beverages.
2. **Full length wine racks located in the upper portion of the cabinet stores 16 bottles of wine on the top two wine racks (8 bottles per wine rack).** Because the wine racks are full length they will store the standard length red and white 750 ml bottles.
3. **Two sturdy, slide out fully extendable wine racks located at the top of the cabinet.**
4. **Two full tempered glass shelves and one half-shelf, all located in the middle to bottom portion of the cabinet, which is used to store non-wine beverages.**
5. **The wine racks have a wooden front facing.**

Whether wines or other non-wine beverages, each are maintained within a temperature range that is suitable for each type of beverage.

Wine is stored in a temperature environment (approximately 45°F) that is suitable for wine. Full length wine racks permit the storage of standard 750 ml wine bottles.

Easy access to all wine bottles, especially those located on the rear portion of the rack. Bottles are stored in a horizontal position keeping the cork moist to prevent air from entering the bottle.

Generous storage for beverages in an approximate 38°F environment which is suitable for these types of beverages.

The wood facing adds to the upscale appearance. The wood is maple and is treated for durability and for use in a temperature controlled environment. The wood facing may be stained or replaced in its entirety by the end user with other wood products or such products as Corian, Sandstone or other like products. | <p>6. Available in stainless steel like finish.</p> | All Beverage Centers have a 2-inch wide brushed aluminum, stainless steel like frame that surrounds a tinted thermal glass door. The cabinet (vinyl clad steel) and grille are black. |
| <p>7. A full length "commercial" style door handle located on either the left side (for right hand hinged) or right side (for left hand hinged) of the door.</p> | Provides a "commercial" appearance. |
| <p>8. Must be ordered either right or left hand door hinged. Not field reversible.</p> | |
| <p>9. Door will open within the outer edge of the cabinet providing "zero clearance" if the door handle is not taken into consideration.</p> | If installing next to another cabinet you can achieve "zero clearance." If installed next to a wall, with the door opening towards the wall, you must allow at least 2 inches of clearance for the door handle in order to achieve a 90-degree door opening. |
| <p>10. Tinted, thermal glass door.</p> | Protects your wines from potentially harmful light rays. |
| <p>11. Built-in or freestanding.</p> | Provides a custom look. No additional clearance around the sides, top or rear for ventilation. Do not obstruct the front grille. If installed freestanding, the anti-tip brackets that are attached to the feet of the 75 BEV should be installed. |
| <p>12. Interior light.</p> | Interior light which can remain either "on" or "off" when the door is closed. The interior light will automatically illuminate when the door is opened. |
| <p>13. Automatic (cycle) defrost.</p> | Maintenance free defrosting. |
| <p>14. Adjustable temperature control.</p> | Ability to adjust the temperature. |
| <p>15. Adjustable leveling legs.</p> | More precise undercounter fit – durable – installed at factory. |
